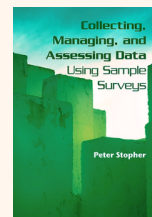
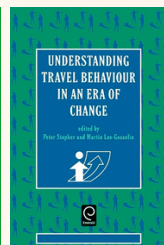
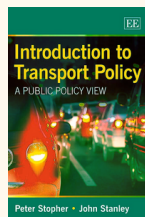
Dr. Stopher is currently a Research Professor in the TOMNET University Transportation Center of the School of Sustainable Engineering and the Built Environment at Arizona State University, a position he has held since 2020. He served as a Professor in the Institute of Transport and Logistics Studies (ITLS) at the University of Sydney between 2001 and 2015. Prior to that, he held faculty positions at Cornell University, Northwestern University, McMaster University, and Louisiana State University. Dr. Stopher has been a pioneering force in transport survey methods, transport modeling, and transport planning and policy for more than 50 years.
